Aboriginal Business Advisors can provide advice, support and referral services including:

- Help clients start up a small business
- Assist in the development of a business plan
- Arrange accredited small business training
- Provide information on financial management
- Provide ongoing mentoring support once a business is up and running
- Provide information on how to apply for funding
- Assist industry groups to engage with Aboriginal businesses
- Indigenous engagement, cultural awareness training
- Consult and advise procurement within industries and companies to increase Indigenous business participation
