Ungooroo as an Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisation (ACCHO) are passionate about targeting hearing loss both in adults and children in our local Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community.

Research has shown the long-term consequences of chronic otitis media which include delay in speech and language development, contributing to learning difficulties, behavioural problems and problems progressing through school.

Ungooroo GP & Health services with the support of Yancoal are very passionate about raising awareness of this problem.

Our staff and registered nurse are accredited and trained in audiology screening for both adults and children.

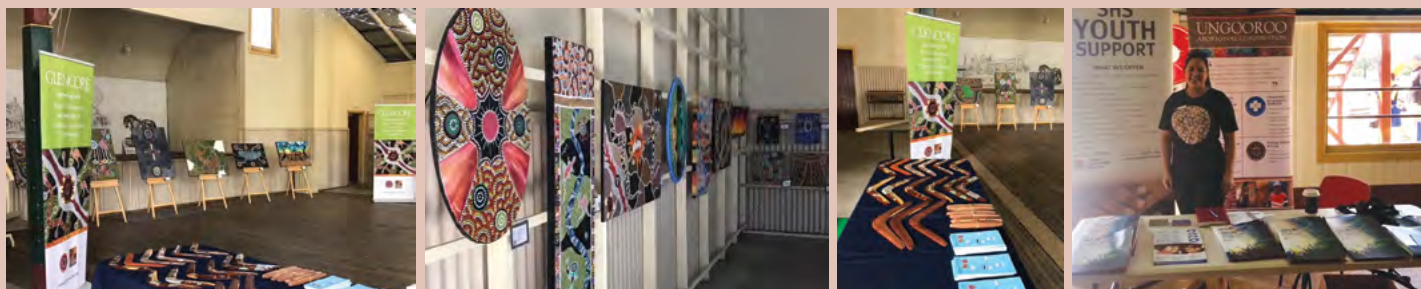

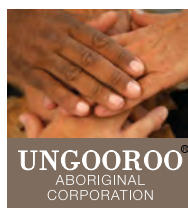
