Situated in Singleton, a 45min drive from Newcastle, Ungooroo GP & Health Services is an Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisation (ACCHO) general practice that is committed to promoting wellness and chronic disease prevention.

We strive to provide a holistic approach to healthcare, utilising our partnership with the NSW Rural Doctors Network to provide allied health services such as Physiotherapy, Psychology, Speech, Diabetes workshops and Optometry. We are in the process of recruiting Occupational Therapists and Ungooroo is also a registered NDIS provider.

We also provide clinical outreach services in Muswellbrook in a central location which offers easy access for community.
